READING

Focus:

- In Reading, students will determine text features of nonfiction texts and their purpose. These include subtitles, captions, photographs, and bold words. Start reading more nonfiction at home so they become more familiar with these terms!
- We will use nonfiction text structures to help guide our understanding of the content. Text structures are what techniques are used; problem/solution, cause/effect, sequencing, compare/contrast, and description

WRITING

Focus:

In Writing, students will be working on nonfiction writing and integrating technology in exciting ways!

MATH

Focus:

- Students will use addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division to solve problems that involve more than one step.
- Students will write multiplication and division equations for comparison problems and solve multiplication and division comparison word problems.
- Multi digit multiplication using rectangle area method
- Long division

Social Studies

Focus: Government and Citizenship

- Students will be analyzing and summarizing the preambles of the United States and North Carolina Constitution.
- Students will discuss how voting rights have changed throughout history.

Focus: Earth Materials

Students will be studying the properties of rocks and minerals by performing various tests on them
